







This building was commissioned by Hasan Talat Efendi, the treasurer of the province Ziya Pasha, the governor of Amasya, in 1865 on the fortification walls of the Hatuniye quarter of Amasya. The mansion was named "HAZERANS" after Lady Hazeran, who lived here for many years The mansion, built on the fortification walls of the ancient period with mud brick infill between two floors with wooden roofs over the basement, was divided into two sections as Haremlik and Selamlik (sections for women and men, respectively). The building is one of the outstanding examples of traditional Ottoman residential architecture and has a closed plan type with a central hall, four iwans and an inner courtyard. Hazeranlar Mansion , which is located on the coast of the Yeşilirmak River and occupies an important place among the model buildings of 19th century civil architecture, was expropriated by our ministry in 1976. Restoration works began in 1979 and were completed in 1983. In 1984 the Mansion was opened as "Museum House" where ethnographic works are exhibited.
