







The house where Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, the founder of the Republic of Türkiye, stayed during his visit to Alanya on February 18th, 1935 is today a museum where his belongings and ethnographic artefacts of Alanya folk culture are exhibited. This Museum is also outstanding to preserve the features of traditional residential architecture as a beautiful example of 19th-century Alanya houses. Belongings and photographs of Atatürk, visuals of the Turkish War of Independence and historical documents and telegrams send by Atatürk to Alanya people can be seen on the ground floor of the Museum, built in three floors reflecting the characteristics of the region and period materials used and layout. Atatürk documentaries can be watched in the movie room.

In the upper floor rooms of the museum, there are traditional clothes, daily use items, embroidery samples of Alanya and its surroundings, jewellery, and weapons. In this section, where the furniture also exhibits periodical features, Alanya folk culture and the way of life are presented to visitors with exhibitions such as 'Wedding in Alanya', 'Alanya Cuisine' and 'Children's Play in Alanya.'' The museum is open every day and can be visited for free.
