
















The museum building was built in 1840 as the mansion of Giridizade Mehmet Pasha, the Treasurer of Karesi Sanjak. After the occupation of Izmir on May 15, 1919, this building, where the people of Balıkesir gathered and the decision for armed struggle in Western Anatolia was made on May 16, 1919, was the headquarters of Corps Command.

The building, which was used as a municipal service building between 1947-1988, was transferred to the General Directorate of Antiquities of the Ministry of Culture in 1988 to be used as a museum. It was restored and opened as "Balıkesir National Forces Museum" on September 6, 1996.







In the exhibition halls, where the names of the ancient cities of Cyzicus, Adramyttium, Dascylium and Antandrus, located within the provincial borders of Balıkesir, are given, there are artifacts found in scientific and rescue excavations and surveys carried out within the provincial borders.
