












Church of Taxiarches general plan (by Sabriye Semra Emek)



Taxiarches Church is the first church of Ayvalık and it is believed to date back to 3 different periods. The building, which was originally built as a small church in the 15th century, is located at the southern garden entrance with the fresco of the representation of the god. The inscription on it dated 1753 provides information about the building from the second period with a three-domed, two-story basilica plan.

From the inscription above the entrance, dated 1844, it appears that the 3rd period basilica was built with a barrel vault and the upper carriers were entirely of wood. Access to the three-nave church is through three main doors in the narthex on the west façade of the building. In the central nave of the church is the pulpit, decorated with plaster reliefs depicting lion figures, and the iconostasis is accessed by a spiral staircase. The cathedral, located on the cross, is decorated with marble reliefs and gold leaf.
