














The ancient city of Kibyra was located at the center of important regions such as Lycia, Phrygia, Caria, Lydia and Pisidia in ancient times.

Three more cities were established around the city, these are; Boubon, Balboura and Oinoanda. Their confederation is called Tetrapolis.

Strabo tells that Kibyrians speak four different languages, namely Solyme, Lydian, Pisid and Hellenic, and are especially skilled in iron inlaying, leather crafts and horse breeding

Kibyra city center is located on three dominant hills. Public and civil buildings are located on the central area of the hills. On the other two hills extending on both sides of it, buildings related to Necropolis are located. Among the places to visit in the city are the Roman Bath, Agora, Theatre, Odeon with the Medusa mosaic made with the Opus sectile technique, Stadion, Basilica, Nymphaeum (Fountain), Necropolis road and many Monumental Tombs.
