

This museum, which opened its doors on the 17th of July 2020, is the largest airport museum in the World, with an area covering 1000m^2 . The museum plans to welcome visitors with a new, temporary exhibition every year. The first exhibition is called 'Treasures of Türkiye: Faces of the Throne'. The objective of the exhibition is to display twelve thousand years of Anatolian history through the concept of 'Rule and Ruler'. The museum's first exhibition serves as a miniature 'Anatolian Civilisations Museum' with over 300 artefacts from the prehistoric, Hittite, Urartu, Phyrgian, Lydian, Roman, Byzantine, Seljuk, Ottoman and modern Turkish periods. With the help of this exhibition, which features 316 artefacts from 27 museums, you will witness thousands of years of Turkish history.
